TDF Taking Applications For The George Williams Young Professional Grant Fund



The purpose of the George Williams Young Professional Grant Fund is to support dressage professionals, ages 25-35, who are committed to the sport and have established businesses as instructors and trainers. Applicants should have a strong desire to participate in continuing education opportunities, in order to provide higher-quality instruction to their students.

The amount of the grants can vary depending on the need and request of the applicants but will typically range from \$3,000 - \$5,000. At this time, one grant will be available each year to a qualified applicant chosen by an independent selection committee.

Grant funding should be used for two purposes:

- 1. To receive training as a rider that is outside of your typical plan (for example, an intensive training time away from home or more lessons from your trainer) AND
- 2. To attend a formal instructor/trainer education program, such as the USDF Instructor/Trainer Program, L Education Program, or other event of your choice that is focused on the education of instructors/trainers.

About the Fund:

Wanting to honor Williams' lifelong commitment to the sport and acknowledge his nine years as President of the United States Dressage Federation (USDF), Janna Dresing, Dr. Jeni Gaffney and Gardy Bloemers initiated the idea of this Fund in December 2018. Dresing shared, "We felt that George has given so much to the dressage community in all of his roles within the USDF, and that creating a scholarship in his name would help honor his commitment to the sport."

Williams was surprised with the news of the Fund at the USDF Salute Gala on December 1st, 2018. After the announcement, he said, "I am honored to have a Grant Fund in my name, which will have a goal of helping up-and-coming young equestrians. Thank you to all the donors."

TDF's President and CEO, Beth Baumert, shared, "Those of us who hold USDF dear will never forget George's many years of wise and steady leadership. His contribution to dressage is impossible to calculate, and he set a fine example for us all. It seems very fitting that this Fund will continue beyond his tenure, giving in his honor."

Greetings Instructors,

Region 9 has a new addition to the Regional Website.

As medicine, saddles, biomechanics information improves with technology it is important that Instructors bring this new information to their client so that the word spreads for the benefit of our horses. It is a given that most Instructors know how to ride, but most of the problems we run into are beyond inside leg/ outside rein. Feed, shoes, inoculations, saddles all play a very important part in keeping our horses sound, and instructors need to be up to date with the latest information.

How it works:

The event must be educational and put on by a GMO, USDF or Region to be recognized. You cannot be the Instructor; you need to be a participant. Have the host of the event sign a letter that has GMO/USDF/ Region Program name: Date; Organizer's signature; Your USDF No. (Individual or Group); Your name printed and signature.

Or print a form off Region 9 website www.usdfregion9.org and send it to the person who will be taking the information at the time, also listed on the website. Either via scan or postal service.

As good as some information was a couple of years ago, changes are always being added and we are going to start recognizing those with attendance this year and keep a running record from year to year. Start checking you local GMO's newsletters or the Region 9 Website for the latest or get your self on the Instructors List to receive the Regional e-news.

This is a very good way for you to advertise your knowledge and enhance your resume' for free on the Regional Website.


Status Update of USEF Freestyle Rule DR 129

Regarding USEF freestyle rule DR 129 which went into effect on December 1, 2018:

During the USEF Board of Directors (BOD) meeting, held April 29, 2019, the USEF BOD reviewed the feedback received and discussed the Extraordinary Rule Change Proposal (Tracking ID# 022-19), regarding DR129. As a result of the discussion, the USEF BOD "felt it was in the best interest of the sport to disapprove the RCP as presented," as stated in the letter from USEF to the affiliate leadership.

The USEF Dressage Sport Committee has submitted an alternative rule change proposal that is currently going through the USEF rule change process. Once this rule change proposal has been certified by the USEF Legislative Committee, it will be available for comment. If certified as an Extraordinary Rule Change, it will be presented to the USEF BOD at their mid-year meeting.

The current USEF Rule DR129 remains in effect. The current rule can be found in the USEF Rule Book on the USEF website, along with the active rule changes and those recently approved by the USEF BOD.
