Proposed ODS Show in OKC Area!

ODS is looking for an ODS member who would be willing to plan a new, at least Level 1, recognized dressage show, close to the Oklahoma City.

ODS is willing to compensate the Show Organizer for their service. This would be a good opportunity for someone to gain new show organizing experience or for someone to add to their business portfolio.

This is not a show manager's position. It could be expanded to include the show manager's position or secretary, but is not included at this time.

The OKC area horse show organizer's role would include developing a budget, locating and contracting with a venue for the horse show, obtaining the licenses, judge, and TD. The role would also include developing the show bill and contracting with a secretary and show manager.

Here are the ideas and considerations for the proposed horse show:

- One ring, one judge, two days
- Format could be several ideas
- Schooling Show/Recognized Show
- Recognized Show/Clinic
- Recognized Show/Western Dressage Lite
- Facility must have two rings (one to show, one for warm-up), or three rings if it includes Western Dressage. There are rules preventing Western Dressage tack in the warm-up ring if a Classical Dressage Show is underway. (Contact Pam DeVore for more information on this format)
- Held near the OKC area, not in Tulsa/Green Country area



Proposed Membership Fee Update to the ODS Policy & Procedures

Due to a USDF fee increase to all GMOs, the ODS Board of Directors feels an ODS membership fee price increase is needed in order to maintain the organization's financial health. At the October meeting, ODS Board members will discuss and vote upon the proposed fee increase. **Comments by ODS members regarding this proposal are welcomed and should be directed to any Board member before October 9th.** If approved this fee structure will begin December 1, 2019.

Reason for Change:

- The ODS Fee Structure in the current Policy and Procedures is out of date.
- It was recently discovered this has not been updated since before the current fee structure was implemented

USDF is increasing the fees due for every GMO for the group membership for each GMO individual/p family. Fee is increasing as of December
 1. 2019. Fee increase is \$4.

The **NEW** proposed wording for the updated ODS Membership Fee Structure is as follows in red:

- 5. The current fee schedule for annual dues is as follows:
 - a. Annual Junior Member \$44
 - b. Annual Senior Member \$54
 - c. Charter/Life \$20
 - d. Family Membership \$54/

primary and one family member / \$10 for each additional family member

e. ODS Chapter membership \$10

This increases the Junior Member, the Senior Member, and the Family Membership fees by \$4 each.

Remember, there is a \$5 discount promotion if you join or renew before December 1. If you join or renew before December 1, 2019 you will save a total of \$9 on your 2020 Membership year.


